What do we do?




Communication

This is a space for them to solve problems and make contacts.













Its purpose is to connect students from Poznań (Mentors) with students participating in the Erasmus+ programme (Mentees).

The Mentor's role is to be a direct and individual support for the Mentee.

Depending on the needs, the Mentor picks up the Mentee from the airport/train station, helps analyse the schedule, shows him/her around the city, etc

It is available to exchange students, Mentors and members of ESN organizations.
















Welcome Days



To properly say goodbye to Poznań and to PUT each year we prepare a fancy Farewell Gala for Erasmus students to enjoy an unforgettable time before heading home















